## CARING FOR YOUR UNIFORM

This guide will signpost you to the RAF Air Cadets official uniform regulations and help you access some hints and tips to help you look your best.

## **AP 1358C**



- **AP 1358C** is the official Uniform Dress and Appearance Regulations for the RAF Air Cadets. It tells you how your uniform should be worn and when you can wear it.

## **CADET PORTAL**



- **Cadet Portal** contains lots of information about your uniform and how to care for it. Find out about how to look after and wear each type of uniform by visiting the **Drill and Uniform** tab.
- Videos are also available via Cadet Portal which show you how to iron or care for certain parts of your blue uniform. Staff can access these videos via the RAFAC Vimeo Channel.

• A virtual brassard shows the badges you have achieved and where they should be placed. Access this via the *My Brassard* tab.





## **GETTING THE CORRECT SIZE**



- Your unit may be able to provide you with a replacement uniform that is the correct size. Your squadron may have your size in stock but it usually has to be ordered, so give your staff as much notice as possible and be as specific as you can with sizes.
- Uniform sizes are mostly in cm. Check the label to see what each number means and measure carefully. Get someone to help you if you can.
